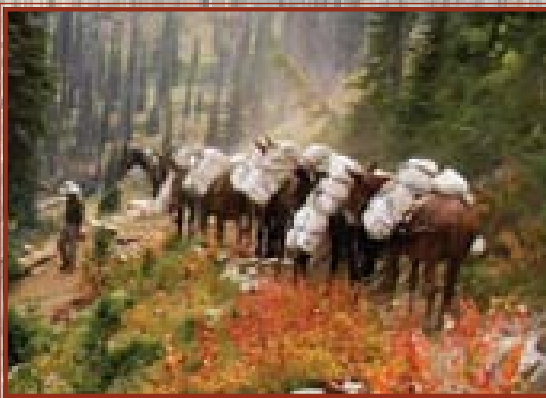

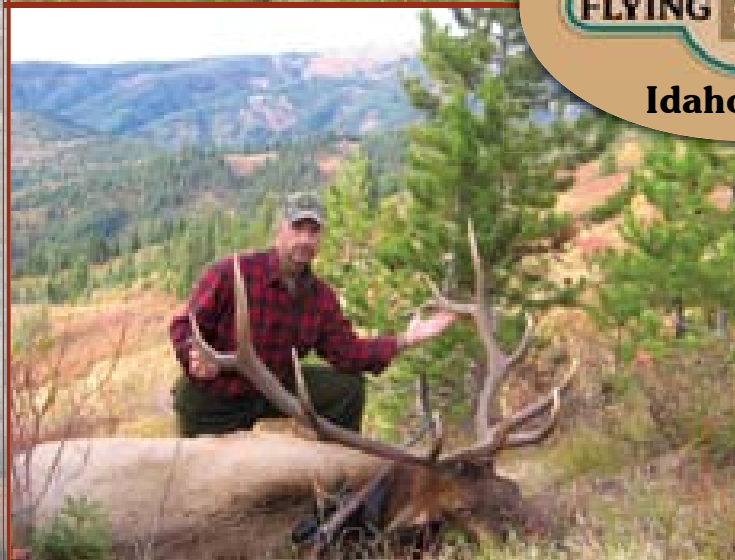
**Licenses & Tags**

The Flying B Ranch makes arrangements for the purchase of licenses and tags for all big game hunts. Non-resident hunters will find Idaho's fees among the lowest in the Rocky Mountain West. In many cases, non-resident hunters may purchase licenses and tags "over the counter" for hunts that would normally require a competitive drawing process in his/her home state.

The Flying B Ranch holds exclusive outfitting rights to over 740,000 acres of the Clearwater & Nez Perce National Forests under special use permit from the United States Forest Service.

Combined with 5,000 deeded acres, the Flying B Ranch offers guests one of the largest land concessions in the state of Idaho for hunting elk, whitetail, mule deer, black bear, turkey, cougar, bobcat, and moose.





**Elk Season**

Archery: August 30—September 30  
Rifle: September 15—November 3

Elk hunts are conducted in remote wilderness areas throughout our territory where our guests are packed-in by horse and mule to enjoy deluxe backcountry camps with full amenities. We maintain a one guide-to-one hunter ratio. In order to maintain trophy quality, we accept a limited number of elk hunters each year. This is elk hunting as it is meant to be.

**Mountain Lion Season**

November 21—March 31

Cougar are hunted with hounds during winter months when the big cats may be taken by rifle, pistol or bow. Hunting begins early in the year in the higher elevations; as winter progresses, we follow the cats to lower elevations as they pursue a more concentrated prey base. The Flying B Ranch provides two guides to each hunter as you pursue your trophy cat.

*Bobcat can be taken for no additional fees during January and February while hunting cougar.*



**Archery Season**

Whitetail, Mule Deer, Elk: August 30—September 30  
Black Bear: April 15—June 30

The Flying B Ranch has exceptional archery hunts for a variety of big game including deer, elk, and bear. Our guides spend countless hours scouting and preparing for our fall hunts to help make your archery experience a success. Archery is done using both spot/stalk and tree stand hunting methods. Whether you choose to stay in our luxury lodge or travel deep into the backcountry, we have an archery hunt for you. You will not find a better value in archery hunting than with the Flying B Ranch. We pride ourselves with well-seasoned guides, exceptional accommodations, and great hunting.



**Deer Season**

Archery: August 30 —September 30  
Whitetail: October 10—December 9  
Mule Deer: October 10—November 3

Whitetail and mule deer hunts are conducted on our 5,000 deeded acre ranch, as well as in our 740,000 acre U.S. Forest Service hunting concession. Accommodations for ranch hunts are at the Flying B Lodge. These hunts sell out every year, so book early to secure your spot! Backcountry hunts are conducted from our deluxe hunting camps where we've done everything to prepare for you a comfortable, successful hunt.

**Bear Season**

April 1—June 30  
September 1—October 31  
(in conjunction with elk & deer hunts)

Black bear hunting at the Flying B Ranch has been booming for years now with an opportunity rate of 90% per year. Colors of the American black bear range from blond, cinnamon, and reddish chocolate to traditional black. Idaho Fish and Game Department estimates the populations of black bears at 2 1/2 bears per square mile in our hunting territory. In most areas, our hunters are allowed to harvest two bears and with five full days to hunt, many experience multiple opportunities. Bear hunting is conducted from both our deluxe backcountry camps and from the Flying B Lodge.



**Turkey Season**

April 15—May 25

Turkey hunting at the Flying B Ranch is most often combined with our Spring Bear hunt. These combination hunts are conducted from our Flying B Lodge where you will enjoy the rustic elegance of our 14,000 square foot lodge and all its amenities. Populations of the Merriam subspecies—now prevalent throughout North Central Idaho—have grown dramatically here on the ranch and two-bird limits are now in effect. Whether your desire is a straight turkey hunt or a bear/turkey combination, the Flying B Ranch is sure to satisfy.

*Turkey hunts can be combined with a Spring Bear hunt for a combination that is sure to satisfy any Big Game enthusiast.*
