Spot & Stalk Spring Bear Hunts in the Selway-Bitterroot Wilderness

Week #1: Open for a single 1:1 hunter or a pair hunting 2:1 Arrive March 31st


Depart April 7th Week #2: Open for up to 4 hunters with 2:1 guiding or 2 individual 1:1 hunters

Arrive April 7th Depart April 14th

These hunts are traditional backcountry spot and stalk hunts with about 80% success. We venture into the Selway just as bears are coming out from hibernation and vegetation is still low, for excellent spotting opportunities. We pack in with horses and mules, bringing in all the equipment needed for a comfortable wilderness stay. Guests enjoy canvas wall tents with wood stoves and excellent food and drinks prepared by a full time camp cook.

We are happy to provide guest references upon request. These hunts are \$4,200 for 2:1 and \$5,200 for 1:1. Hunters can take 2 bears with reduced tags of \$41.75 and no trophy fees on 2nd bears. You may also bring in wolf tags with no trophy fees on wolves. Non-resident licenses are \$164.75.

This hunt is an opportunity to pursue Rocky Mountain bull elk in the opening week of a special archery only season in the backcountry of Idaho. Hunt with our experienced archery elk guides and on-call packer. We pack in with horses and mules, bringing in all the equipment needed for a comfortable backcountry stay. Guests enjoy canvas wall tents with wood stoves and excellent food and drinks prepared by a full time camp cook. We are happy to provide guest references upon request. These hunts are \$4,200 for 2:1 and \$5,200 for 1:1. We take care of issuing elk tags for you which are \$416.75 and non-resident licenses are \$164.75.
